MOBISKILLS 2024



The Erasmus+ project **MOBISKILLS 2024**, coordinated by **Istituto di Istruzione Superiore “Luigi di Savoia”** of **Rieti** and promoted in the framework of the **VET Accreditation 2021-2027**, aims to **promote international mobility, improve the technical-professional, linguistic, digital, key and transversal skills** of participants (**fourth-year students in initial vocational training and recent graduates**), strengthen collaborations between schools and between them and international partners, contributing to the innovation of their training offer and to the consolidation of openness to the international dimension.

Through the internship activities lasting **30 days** (students) and **90 days** (recent graduates), which will be carried out in **innovative companies and organizations** in the **social care sectors** (but not only) of **Malta, Spain and Poland** and the competent guidance of company mentors, participants will acquire innovative technical skills, as well as green, digital, linguistic and transversal skills (**resilience, flexibility, problem solving, autonomy, relational skills, teamworking**), such as to contribute to innovating and raising the quality of services offered by local and regional companies in the sector. The international activities will also allow the Consortium schools

to update their social care professional profiles and other professional profiles that will be of interest to international mobility in line with their training offer and the skills needs of local/regional businesses and sector operators. Finally, mobility activities will contribute to the development of the **European Education Area** in the social care sectors through the **recognition and certification of the learning outcomes** acquired by participants according to national and European transparency standards and procedures (EQAVET, EQF, ECVET, Europass Portfolio and PCTO training credits).
